Project ideas are generated from pool members, pools in neighboring municipalities, Recreation Department research, and pool trade recommendations. The projects are designed to maintain and improve the existing facility, enhance the value of pool membership, and prepare for maintenance needs before they arise. We hope you will benefit from these improvements and enjoy your summer at the pool!

MAIN AND BABY POOLS

- Address potential remaining leaks
- Architectural design of new main building and kid's pool area
- Purchase 2-3 free-standing umbrellas for inside the baby pool fence
- Spill container for chlorine tank
- Safety sleeves on hand rails to steps and diving board

BUILDINGS

- Unclog floor drains in locker rooms

GROUNDS

- Purchase more lounge chairs
- Install two additional shade structures
- Replace exterior fencing along driveway adjacent to hockey/basketball/shuffleboard
- Demolish one racquetball court
- Install retractable decorative awning above lifeguard room*
- Create free Wi-Fi access for patrons
- Replace two wooden picnic tables with coated picnic tables
- Refurbish bocce courts
- Heavier sign boards for "no running," "watch your children," "no eating outside concession"
- Informational signs at bocce, shuffleboard, and horseshoes
- Purchase 1-2 custom garbage cans
- Purchase a second book cart

CONCESSION

- General concession area improvements
(Including four umbrellas for square concession picnic tables)

MAIN ENTRANCE

- Install a permanent pool sign above main entrance to replace banner*
- Install decorative awning above main entrance*
- Purchase laptop for registering guests and collecting payments
