Program Details:

- The program is open to girls in Springfield schools in 4th-9th grades.
- In our travel league, teams play games against surrounding towns home and away.
- Players are required to play in full equipment. See below.

Practices and Field Information:

- Practice fields and game fields will be announced and are subject to change. Season begins March 1st (dependent on weather and field conditions). We plan to schedule games on weekend mornings, and some weeknights if possible.
- 4th-6th grade team practices on Tuesday and Thursday (time to be determined).
- 7th-9th grade team practices on Monday and Thursday (time to be determined).

Three Fees:

What's Included:

- Lacrosse coaching. Tons of playing time!

- Loaned to goalies: stick, helmet, throat guard, gloves, pelvic protection, thigh and shin protector, chest protector.

- End-of-season family BBQ (separate registration required).
