Mission

The Recreation Department offers a wide variety of high quality and affordable year-round leisure programs for Springfield residents of all ages – as well as extensive senior citizen services, afterschool teen drop-in program, Springfield Community Pool, Spring Fest and Egg Hunt, Halloween Spooktacular, and Holiday Celebration and Tree Lighting. Programs are intended to support, regulate, and encourage participation in a healthy and active lifestyle; and to facilitate the use and enjoyment of township parks and recreational facilities for the residents of Springfield.

Online Registration

In addition to paper registration forms, the Recreation Department offers the convenience of registering for most programs online with a credit card through Community Pass. Senior Citizen Services

The Recreation Department sponsors activities for all senior citizen residents of Springfield, such as a free fitness room and weekly fitness classes, bus trips, health clinics, speakers, breakfasts, movies, entertainment, Black History Month program, Super Bowl party, Mother's Day brunch, Father's Day lunch, gardening program, and more. The Springfield Senior Citizens Club is an affiliated organization that meets regularly at the Chisholm Community Center. A variety of programs are offered, such as cards, Bingo, monthly meetings, birthday luncheons, and more. To join the club and/or the fitness membership, download the forms on our website or pick them up at the Chisholm Community Center. A monthly activities calendar can be downloaded on our website and is also available at the Chisholm Community Center.

The Recreation Department offers free weekday bus transportation for senior citizens to locations within the township, such as grocery stores, salons, doctor offices, fitness clubs, banks, Senior Citizens Club meetings, library, post office, and more. To make a reservation, residents can call (973) 912-2227 between 8:00-9:00 am to schedule an appointment for that day. The bus service runs from 9:00 am-4:00 pm, Monday-Friday. Bus service is unavailable on municipal holidays, and due to inadvertent weather or staffing conditions. The bus is equipped with a passenger lift for wheelchairs. Other riders should be able to board and depart the bus independently. New riders are asked to complete an emergency contact form. The bus was generously donated by Investors Bank Foundation.
