Residential Trash Collection (Type 10)

Trash collection is provided weekly by a third party contractor, included in your annual tax bill.

Collection is on <u>Thursdays</u> for residents on the <u>south side of Mountain Ave</u> and <u>Fridays for residents</u> on the north side of Mountain Ave.

Summer (May 27th thru August 29th) biweekly pickup is provided on Mondays and Thursdays for the south side of Mountain Ave. and Tuesdays and Fridays for the north side of Mountain Ave.

Plastic bags are not recyclable. Recycling in plastic bags will not be collected

Material accepted: All electronics-

Branches less than 4 inches in diameter, in proper bin Leaves, grass and soft vegetative material, in the proper bin. White clean Styrofoam- no food service foam.

Illegal dumping will be prosecuted.

Spring Cleanup

During the entire month of April,

DPW crews will canvass the town in the garbage packer truck for vegetative waste.

Branches 4 inches in diameter and smaller, leaves and grass will be collected.

Please note material must be placed in paper recyclable bags or cans Loose debris in the roadway will not be picked up!!

Beginning May 1st residents may drop off grass clippings and soft vegetative waste at the <u>Springfield</u> <u>Pool Recycling Convenience Center.</u>

Manned Hours: Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, 7:30-11:30am

Union County and the Township of Springfield encourage residents to adopt a cut it and leave it grass program.

2025 Leaf Collection

November 1st - Dec 31

Residents on Township Roads may start placing leaves in the street on October 23rd.

Make sure your landscaper knows that only grass and leaves will be collected curbside. No branches!!

- Make sure not to place leaves closer than 10 feet from any storm drain or catch basin. (NJDEP Stormwater Regulation)
- Make sure no branches or sticks are placed at the curb, they will not be picked up.
- Leaf collection ends on December 31st, At which point the street sweeper will be deployed to sweep Township streets.

Snow Reminder

Please do not park in the roadway when crews are plowing the streets. It is essential that crews can plow the road ways in their entirety to allow for drainage (curb to curb plowing). No one wants their driveway plowed in, but this is a safety issue for pedestrians, motorists, and emergency services. Please refrain from dumping snow back into the roadway.

Latex Paint will "Not" be accepted, Latex paint should be dried out and put in your regular trash with the lid removed.
