

Explanation: This resolution authorizes the Township of Springfield to procure electricity supply services for public use via an online auction website.

**TOWNSHIP OF SPRINGFIELD
RESOLUTION NO. 2026-240**

WHEREAS, the Local Government Electronic Procurement Act (P.L. 2018, c. 156) (the “Act”) authorizes the purchase of electricity supply service for public use through the use of an online auction service; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Springfield (“Township”) has determined to move forward with the EMEX Reverse Auction in order procure electricity for the Township; and

WHEREAS, Township will utilize the online auction services of EMEX, LLC, a division of Mantis Innovation, an approved vendor pursuant to the Act; and

WHEREAS, EMEX, LLC, a division of Mantis Innovation, is compensated for all services rendered through the participating supplier that a contract is awarded to; and

WHEREAS, the auction will be conducted pursuant to the Act; and

WHEREAS, if the auction achieves a price of \$0.09604/kWh or less for a 12 month term, a price of \$0.09613/kWh or less for an 18 month term, a price of \$0.09614/kWh or less for a 24 month term; the Township may award a contract to the winning supplier for the selected term.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Springfield, County of Union, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The above recitals are incorporated as though set forth at length herein.
2. The Township is authorized to participate in the upcoming electricity supply service auction conducted by EMEX, LLC.
3. If the auction achieves a price of \$0.09604/kWh or less for a 12 month term, a price of \$0.09613/kWh or less for an 18 month term, a price of \$0.09614/kWh or less for a 24 month term; then the Township’s Chief Financial Officer, on behalf of the Township, may award a contract to the supplier with the winning bid for the selected term pursuant to the results of the upcoming EMEX, LLC online auction, and execute on Township’s behalf an electricity contract proffered by the participating supplier that submits the winning bid in the EMEX, LLC online auction.
4. The Chief Financial Officer shall report the results of the Auction to the Township Committee and Township Administrator.
5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

TAKE NOTE that the foregoing Resolution was adopted at the Regular Meeting by the Township Committee, of the Township of Springfield, County of Union, State of New Jersey, on Tuesday, August 18, 2026.
